Cats should be at least 5 months of age before we consider them a good candidate for neuter.



## Standard Neuter

What does this include? What does this includer The base price includes a pre-surgical exam, general anesthesia, the surgical procedure, appropriate pain medications, and post-op therapeutic laser.

FeLV/FIV test

VACCINES

A simple blood test that tests for two serious immunosuppressive diseases in cats

First vaccines or booster vaccines to protect your cat from common dieseases

LASER PACKAGE MICROCHIP

CO2 laser that allows for less bleeding, and faster healing times

What else do we recommend?

Includes implantation and registration in the case that your pet gets lost!



### Preparing for the Big Day





- DO plan on dropping on between 7:45-8:30 am th morning of the procedure
- DO allow 10-15 minutes for a technician to reviet the consent form
- DO plan on picking up the day of the procedure between 4:30-6 pm
- DO allow 10-15 minutes for review of the discharge instructions
- DO NOT feed anything after 10 pm the night before the procedure
- DO NOT withhold water overnight
- DO NOT allow any running, jumping or playing while the incision is healing (10-14 days)
- DO NOT allow your pet to lick at their incision!
